The **emergency** meeting of the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 2142, St. Louis County Schools, was held at ISD # 2142 District Office on Monday, **January 29, 2007**, at 3:32 p.m.

Member B. Larson introduced the following resolution and moved as follows:

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
OF HEARING OFFICER AND TO EXPEL STUDENT "X3-07"
FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR.**

WHEREAS, the administration had proposed student "X3-07" for expulsion in that there is substantial evidence that said student committed a serious and flagrant violation of school district policy, and the laws of the state of Minnesota, to-wit: student X3-07 was insubordinate to and verbally assaulted a school employee on school grounds and school locations, and has failed to remediate and correct his behavior in conjunction with prior similar incidents for which he had been warned; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pupil Fair Dismissal Act, student "X3-07" requested a hearing in conjunction with his proposed expulsion; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held and conducted on January 24, 2007, before independent hearing officer Gail Murray who, based upon her review of the evidence submitted at the hearing, has submitted her Findings and Recommendation to the Board of Education;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the school board of Independent School District No. 2142, St. Louis County Schools, to adopt the Findings of the independent hearing officer as its Findings, and to, further, accept the hearing officer's recommendation to expel student "X3-07" for a period of one year;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the school board of Independent School District No. 2142, St. Louis County Schools, that student "X3-07" be expelled for a period of one year.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Fowler and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor thereof: Bruns, Bjerklie, Fowler, A. Larson, B. Larson, Krog and Salmela.

and the following voted against the same: None.

Whereupon, said resolution was declared duly passed and adopted.
