Superintendent Rick reported the following: 1.) The Superintendent will attend the following graduation ceremonies: Tower-Soudan School, Thursday, May 27, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.; Orr School, Friday, May 28, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. and Cook School, Saturday, May 29, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.; 2.) Last Friday, May 21, 2010, the Superintendent met and talked with the Cherry School elementary students; 3.) On Friday, May 14, 2010 the Student Advisory met at the District Office. It was a very positive meeting and the students had very thoughtful questions and comments. A summary of the meeting is being completed by a student from the Babbitt-Embarrass School.

AlBrook School Principal, Kristi Berlin reported the following: *Academics:* AlBrook staff is working hard to meet the needs of students. ILP's for G55 students and below are being established. This is a student plan to assist in tracking struggling student interventions and test scores; *Elementary Curriculum:* Elementary teachers are looking at the needs of students which include: Literacy Groups; Concentration on Math Facts; Recess before Lunch and 20-20-20; Title Services and Indian Education Tutors; and After School Help from teachers, which include a late bus for students; *Middle School Curriculum:* 7th and 8th grade students have been working in a very structured math fundamentals course. Staff implemented Math Thursdays to work on math skills with the

G55 students; *High School Curriculum*: The principal spent the day with seniors to assist them with college and scholarship applications and the FAFSA. FDLTCC tested the 10-11 students to help them see the areas they will need to work on in high school; *Class of 2010*: There are 30 graduating seniors with 80% of them planning on attending college in the fall. They have received over \$225,000 in scholarships and student taking college courses are transferring 30+ credits; *Academic Programs for Students*: Math Masters; Science Fair; Academic Journey; Skills Competition for Technical Skills; and Poetry Out Loud Competitions; *After School Programs*: LEGO Machines for grades 3-4; NASA Programs for grade 5; Elementary newspaper for grades 3-6; Robotics for grades 7-12 and Little Falcons for grades PK-6; *Other Programs*: Middle School Band Festival 5-8 grades students performs at the festival in Two Harbors; AlBrook and Cotton elementary grades 5 and 6 students have been having learning retreats at the Cotton Forest this year; High School art students have participated in this year's MSHSL Art Contest. An AlBrook student won Best in Media Art for the NE area; and there was an annual duct tape boat project. Tech students designed and built boats using a variety of structural materials including duct tape.

Kristi Berlin and Markus Hoche reported on technology. At a recent District Office technology meeting the following subjects were discussed: *Concerns*: Support staff and to have a New Equipment plan that would be the same for all schools; *Summer of 2010 Timeline*: Review the 08-11 Technology Plan; Examine equipment; Develop a district stand for technology and training for equipment; *Fall of 2010*: Develop training material for teachers; *Spring and Summer of 2011*: Train staff on new equipment and install new equipment. Implement cloud applications and forms; Security cameras / doors and phones; *Technology and Curriculum*: To have technology enhance curriculum and education.
